- 18.  $\Box$  Each party shall provide the other party with 48 hours' notice when taking the child(ren) out of state for more than  $\Box 24 \Box 48 \Box$  hours unless previously agreed upon by the parties.
- 19.  $\Box$  Each party shall make a telephone available if the child(ren) want to contact the noncustodial party.
- 20.  $\Box$  Each party shall ensure the child(ren) attend school except for illness or appointments or school approved educational excursions as agreed upon by the parties.
- 21.  $\Box$  Each party shall encourage the child(ren) to comply with the custody agreement and foster in the child(ren) a positive view of the other party.
- 22. □ The parties may decide different time arrangements and make decisions for the child(ren) whenever they mutually agree to do so. Nothing in this agreement is understood to limit or restrict the ability of the parties to mutually agree on alternative custody arrangements. If for any reason the parties cannot agree, the terms of this consent agreement will be followed.
- 23.  $\Box$  Neither party may relocate with the child(ren) without approval of the other party or the Court.

- 25. □ Jurisdiction of the child(ren) shall remain with the Court of Common Pleas of Bedford County, Pennsylvania, unless or until jurisdiction would change under the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Act.
- 26. VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER BY ANY PERSON MAY RESULT IN CIVIL AND CRIMINAL PENALTIES, INCLUDING PROSECUTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 2904 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CRIMES CODE, INTERFERENCE WITH CUSTODY OF CHILDREN.
